**Application and Decision Dates for admission to the 2022/2023 school year**

The following are the dates applicable for admission to Junior Infants

The school will commence accepting applications for admission on	<b>10<sup>th</sup> January 2022</b>
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	<b>1<sup>st</sup> February 2022 @12 noon</b>
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is	<b>22<sup>nd</sup> February 2022</b>
The date by which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is *	<b>1<sup>st</sup> March 2022</b>
